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Sion ROB closure to hit 200 BEST buses

Mumbai: The closure of the Sion road over bridge (ROB), planned from today, will disrupt the BEST bus travel pattern, leading to inconvenience for daily passengers. The move will impact more than 200 buses plying daily on 24 routes. According to BEST spokesperson Sunil Vaidya, the diversions

Close to solitary mangrove, 2 Nerul bldgs can add floors

Barred for years from adding floors to their buildings, two housing societies in Nerul will now be able to undertake the extension using their available floor space index (FSI) after seeking permission from the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC).

As per the Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority (MCZMA) rules, the buildings are within the 50m buffer zone of mangroves. The societies, howev-

er, claimed that there is one solitary mangrove tree at a distance of 48.2m from one of the plots.

The societies said they don't want to remove the tree but said that the 50m buffer zone around a solitary tree is not only irrational and arbitrary but also contrary to plain common sense.

However, when they were denied an NOC, they ap-

proached the Bombay High Court, which observed that a solitary mangrove tree does not require a buffer zone of 50m. The court remarked that it failed to understand how additional floors on existing buildings cannot be allowed only because the construction would somehow "pose a deathly peril to this one tree".

The judges agreed with the

societies, saying that the public authorities, including the NMMC, are routinely engaged in mega projects and sought court's permission to destroy acres and acres of mangroves, citing an "overriding public interest". Directing the NMMC to issue a development permission and commencement certificate to the petitioners, the court termed the civic body's demand for NOC from MCZMA as "bizarre", and said that the coastal authority's approval is unjustified and uncalled for.

While the Surat Diamond Bourse has emerged as the crown jewel of India's gem and jewellery trade, a new contender is set to sparkle on the horizon: the India Jewellery Park in Navi Mumbai. The Gem and Jewellery Export Promotion Council and the Maharashtra government signed a memorandum of understanding at the World Economic Forum on January 18 to build the world's largest such facility at Rs50,000 crore.

Council Chairman Vipul Shah said, "The collaboration is an immense privilege and a source of great pride, representing a shared commitment with the Maharashtra Government to propel the gem and jewellery

Nonprofit can challenge MCZMA nod to Balaji temple

Amid growing "ecological concerns" on the construction of the Tirupati Balaji temple at Sector 12 in Ulwe, the National Green Tribunal (NGT) has permitted the NatConnect Foundation to file a fresh application against the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) nod granted to the project.

While hearing the matter on January 12, the NGT allowed the move after counsel Ronita Bhattacharya - representing NatConnect - averred that Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority (MCZMA) permitted the constructions of a compound wall and lawn in 50 metres of the mangrove buffer zone. The decision violates the CRZ norms, Bhattacharya alleged.

At this point, the NGT's western zonal bench also noted that the MCZMA had issued a letter to Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam on November 20, allowing temple construction on the 'non-CRZ area'. Highlighting that the MCZMA's permission letter is still not in public domain, Bhattacharya contended that even the temple plot is part of the temporary casting yard of the Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL).

The counsel pointed out that the MCZMA report to the NGT, disclosed for the first time, stated that the temple plot is part of the MTHL casting yard, a fact that apparently didn't figure in the Authority's minutes of the meeting that recommended

- The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on 19/01/2024.
- The Board of Directors at the meeting held on 28/04/2023 approved a Scheme of Amalgamation (Scheme) of UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Limited (UNCL) (a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company) and its wholly-owned subsidiaries viz. Swiss Merchandise Infrastructure Limited (Swiss) and Merit Plaza Limited (Merit) with the Company. The National Company Law Tribunal ("NCLT"), Mumbai Bench has approved the Scheme and the NCLT, Kolkata Bench has fixed the date of hearing for sanction of the Scheme on 08/02/2024.
- The Company has acquired a 0.54 mtpa cement grinding assets of Burnpur Cement Limited, located at Patrati in Jharkhand at a consideration of ₹ 169.79 crores in terms of the provisions of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 read with the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002.
- The Board of Directors have approved a Composite Scheme of Arrangement between Kesoram Industries Limited, the Company and their respective shareholders and creditors, in compliance with sections 230 to 232 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Scheme"). The Scheme, inter alia, provides for: (a) demerger of the Cement Business of Kesoram into the Company, and (b) reduction and cancellation of the preference share capital of Kesoram. The Cement Business of Kesoram consists of 2 integrated cement units at Sedam (Karnataka) and Basantnagar (Telangana) with a total installed capacity of 10.75 mtpa and 0.66 mtpa packing plant at Solapur, Maharashtra. The Company will issue 1 (one) equity share of the Company of face value ₹ 10/- each for every 52 (fifty-two) equity shares of Kesoram of face value ₹ 10/- each to the shareholders of Kesoram on the record date defined in the Scheme. The Scheme is, inter alia, subject to receipt of requisite approvals from statutory and regulatory authorities, including from the stock exchanges, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), the National Company Law Tribunals, the Competition Commission of India and the shareholders and creditors of the Company.
- The Company incorporated a Wholly-owned Subsidiary viz. "Letein Valley Cement Limited" in Shillong, Meghalaya on 16/01/2024 to carry on the business of mining of limestone and other raw materials; manufacture and sale of cement.
- During the nine months ended 31/12/2023, provision for current and deferred tax expenses has been recognized as per the new tax regime adopted by the Company from the financial year 2023-24 in terms of provision of Section 115BAA of Income tax Act, 1961.
- In terms of a Scheme of Arrangement between Jaiprakash Associates Limited (JAL), Jaypee Cement Corporation Limited (JCCL), the Company ("the Parties") and their respective shareholders and creditors, sanctioned by the National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai and Allahabad bench, together with necessary approvals from the stock exchanges, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), and the Competition Commission of India, the Company had on 27/06/2017, issued Series A Redeemable Preference Shares of ₹ 1,000 crores to JAL (Series A RPS) for a period of 5 years or such longer period as may be agreed by the Parties (the "Term"). The Series A RPS were held in escrow until satisfaction of certain conditions precedent in relation to the Dalia Super Plant and mines situated in the state of Uttar Pradesh (Earlier known as JP Super), to be redeemed post the expiry of the Term as per the agreement between the Parties. Upon expiry of the Term, the Company offered redemption of the Series A RPS within the stipulated number of days, post adjustment of certain costs pertaining to the conditions precedent, as per the terms of the agreement entered into between the Parties. Redemption of the Series A RPS was subject to issuance of a joint notice to the escrow agent. The Series A RPS could not be redeemed due to inaction on the part of JAL in signing the joint instruction notice. This matter has since been referred to arbitration and the proceedings are pending.
- The Company had filed appeals against the orders of the Competition Commission of India (CCI) dated 31/08/2016 (Penalty of ₹ 1,449.51 Crores) and 19/01/2017 (Penalty of ₹ 68.30 Crores). Upon the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal ("NCLAT") dismissing its appeal against the CCI order dated 31/08/2016, the Company filed an appeal before Hon'ble Supreme Court which has, by its order dated 05/10/2018, granted a stay against the NCLAT order. Consequently, the Company has deposited an amount of ₹ 144.95 Crores equivalent to 10% of the penalty of ₹ 1,449.51 Crores. The Company, backed by legal opinions, believes that it has a good case in both the matters and accordingly no provision has been recognised in the results. UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Ltd (UNCL) has also filed an appeal before Hon'ble Supreme Court against a similar CCI order dated 31/08/2016 and has deposited an amount of ₹ 16.73 Crores equivalent to 10% of the penalty amount of ₹ 167.32 Crores. The Company, backed by legal opinion believes that it has a good case in the said matter and accordingly no provision has been recognised in the results.

अमरावती : आंध्र प्रदेश सरकारने शुक्रवारपासून संपूर्ण राज्यात व्यापक जातनिहाय जनगणनेची सुरुवात केली. राज्यातील सर्व जाती समुदायांचा या जनगणनेत समावेश करण्यात आला आहे. माहिती व जनसंपर्क मंत्री सी. श्रीनिवास वेणुगोपाल कृष्णा यांनी १९ जानेवारीपासून दहा दिवस ही जनगणना चालेल, असे सांगितले आहे. बिहारनंतर जातनिहाय जनगणना करणारे आंध्र प्रदेश हे देशातील दुसरे राज्य ठरले आहे. एकाच टप्प्यात व्यापक जनगणना हाती घेण्यात आली असून ती दहा दिवसांत पूर्ण करण्यात येणार आहे. आंध्र प्रदेशचे माहिती व जनसंपर्क मंत्री सी. श्रीनिवास वेणुगोपाल कृष्णा यांनी ही माहिती दिली. ते म्हणाले की, जातनिहाय जनगणना १९ जानेवारी रोजी सुरु झाली असून ती १० दिवस चालेल. गरज पडल्यास चार ते पाच दिवस वाढवून दिले जातील. जनगणना करणारे स्वयंसेवक प्रत्येक घराला भेट देतील. तेथे जातनिहाय सर्व माहिती जमा करतील. ही माहिती ग्रामीण सचिवालय व्यवस्थेला पाठवण्यात येईल. कृष्णा पुढे म्हणाले की, राज्यभरातील ग्रामीण सचिवालय व्यवस्था या माहितीतील सत्यता पडताळून पाहिल व खात्री झाल्यानंतरच माहितीची नोंद केली जाईल. प्रत्येक स्वयंसेवक ५० घरांची माहिती जमा करेल. देशात लोकसभा निवडणुका जाहीर होण्याआधी १५ फेब्रुवारीच्या आत ही जनगणना प्रक्रिया पूर्ण केली जाईल, असा विश्वास कृष्णा यांनी व्यक्त केला आहे.

नवी दिल्ली : बिल्किस बानो सामूहिक बलात्कार प्रकरणातील ११ गुन्हेगारांची शिक्षा माफ करण्याचा गुजरात सरकारचा निर्णय सुप्रीम कोर्टाने रद्द केल्यानंतर या दोषींनी आत्मसमर्पणात मुदतवाढ देण्याची याचिका न्यायालयात दाखल केली होती. ही याचिका सुप्रीम कोर्टाने शुक्रवारी फेटाळून लावत ११ दोषींना रविवार, २१ जानेवारीपर्यंत आत्मसमर्पण करण्याचे आदेश दिले आहेत.

दोन आठवड्यांपूर्वी याप्रकरणी सुप्रीम कोर्टात सुनावणी झाली आणि कोर्टाने गुजरात सरकारला खडेबोल सुनावले होते. तसेच आरोपींची शिक्षा माफ करण्याचा निर्णय रद्द केला होता. या प्रकरणातील ११ दोषींनी पोलिसांसमोर आत्मसमर्पण करण्यासाठी मुदत



वाढवून मागितली होती. परंतु, सुप्रीम कोर्टाने ही मागणी धुडकावली आहे. या याचिकेला काहीही अर्थ नाही, असे न्यायालयाने म्हटले आहे. बिल्किस बानो प्रकरणातील दोषी गोविंदभाई नाई, रमेश रुपाभाई चंदना आणि मितेश चिमणलाल भट यांनी वेगवेगळी कारणे देत आत्मसमर्पणासाठी चार आठवड्यांची मुदत वाढवून मागितली होती. गोविंदभाई नाई याने सर्वोच्च

महुआ मोईत्रा यांनी अखेर सरकारी बंगला सोडला

नवी दिल्ली : हकालपट्टी केलेल्या लोकसभा खासदार महुआ मोईत्रा यांनी शुक्रवारी अखेर येथील सरकारी बंगला रिकामा केला. निष्कासनाच्या कारवाईला स्थगिती देण्याची त्यांची याचिका दिल्ली उच्च न्यायालयाने फेटाळल्यानंतर एका दिवसात ही कारवाई केली गेली.

त्यांचे वकील शादान फरासत म्हणाले की, टेलिग्राफ लेनवरील घर क्रमांक ९ बी हे निवासस्थान अधिकारी येण्यापूर्वी सकाळी १० वाजता रिकामे झाले होते. कोणतीही कारवाई अधिकाऱ्यांना करावी लागली नाही.

केंद्रीय गृहनिर्माण आणि नागरी व्यवहार मंत्रालयाच्या अंतर्गत येणाऱ्या इस्टेट संचालनालयाने सकाळी बंगला रिकामा करण्यासाठी एक पथक पाठवले होते. आजूबाजूचा परिसर त्यासाठी संरक्षितही करण्यात आला होता. या आठवड्याच्या

सुरुवातीला डीओईने मोईत्रा यांना घर खाली करण्याची नोटीस जारी केली. या संबंधात एका अधिकाऱ्याने सांगितले की, बंगल्याचा ताबा अधिकृतपणे संपदा संचालनालयाकडे सुपुर्द करण्यात आला आहे. मालमत्तेचे काही नुकसान झाले आहे का, याचे आम्ही मूल्यांकन करत आहोत.

गुरुवारी मोईत्रा यांना दिल्ली उच्च न्यायालयाकडून कोणताही दिलासा मिळू शकला नाही आणि त्यामुळे डीओईच्या नोटीशीला स्थगिती देण्यास नकार दिला आणि त्यांना सरकारी बंगला रिकामा करण्यास सांगितले. न्यायाधीश गिरीश कटपलिया म्हणाले की, खासदारांचे खासदार राहण्याचे सोडून दिल्यानंतर त्यांना सरकारी निवासस्थानातून बाहेर काढण्याचा कोणताही विशिष्ट नियम न्यायालयासमोर आणला गेला नाही.

वडोदरा : वडोदराजवळील हरणी येथे बोट दुर्घटनेत १४ विद्यार्थी आणि दोन शिक्षकांचा बळी गेला होता. त्या प्रकरणी पोलिसांनी हत्येचा गुन्हा दाखल करून तीन जणांना अटक केली आहे.

वडोदरा शहराच्या बाहेरील हरणी तलावात बोट बुडून झालेल्या दुर्घटनेत ९

विद्यार्थी आणि दोन शिक्षकांना वाचवण्यात आले. हे सर्व तेथे सहलीला गेले होते. मात्र या दुर्घटनेमुळे पोलिसांनी कोटिया प्रोजेक्टच्या भागीदारांसह १८ जणांविरुद्ध भारतीय दंडसंहितेच्या कलम ३०४ (दोषी हत्येचा प्रयत्न) आणि ३०८ (दोषी हत्येचा प्रयत्न) अन्वये एफआयआर नोंदविला आहे. कोटिया प्रकल्पाच्या भागीदारांना पालिकेने तलाव करारावर वपनारपास दिला होता. पोलीस उपयुक्त पान मोगया यांनी सांगितले की, आम्ही हरणी तलाव झोनचे व्यवस्थापक शांतीलाल सोळंकी आणि नयन गोहिल व अंकित या दोन बोटचालकांना अटक केली आहे. इतर दोषींना पकडण्याचे प्रयत्न सुरु आहेत. या घटनेत १४ शालेय विद्यार्थी आणि २ महिला शिक्षकांना आपला जीव गमवावा लागला, तर तलावातील बचावकार्य कारवाई गुरुवारी रात्री संपली. दरम्यान,

बोट दुर्घटनेत मृत्युमुखी पडलेल्या आपल्या मुलांवर गुरुवारी रात्री उशिरा काही कुटुंबीयांनी अंत्यसंस्कार केले. वडोदरा महानगरपालिकेने २०१७ मध्ये कोटिया प्रकल्पांना हरणी लेक झोन, एक मनोरंजन केंद्र चालवण्याचे आणि देखरेखीचे कंत्राट दिले होते. पालिकेचे



अभियंता राजेश चौहान यांनी त्यांच्या तक्रारीत म्हटले आहे की, फर्म, तिचे मालक, व्यवस्थापक आणि बोटचालकांनी अनेक कारणांवर गुन्हेगारी निष्काळजीपणा केला आहे, मग ते बोटीची देखभाल न करणे किंवा जीवन रक्षक उपकरणे आणि लाइफ जॅकेटची पुरेशी संख्या न ठेवणे अशा स्वरूपातील निष्काळजीपणा केला गेला आहे.

- The Board of Directors at the meeting held on 28/04/2023 approved a Scheme of Amalgamation (Scheme) of UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Limited (UNCL) (a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company) and its wholly-owned subsidiaries viz. Swiss Merchandise Infrastructure Limited (Swiss) and Merit Plaza Limited (Merit) with the Company, The National Company Law Tribunal ("NCLT"), Mumbai Bench has approved the Scheme and the NCLT, Kolkata Bench has fixed the date of hearing for sanction of the Scheme on 08/02/2024.
- The Company has acquired a 0.54 mtpa cement grinding assets of Burnpur Cement Limited, located at Patratu in Jharkhand at a consideration of ₹ 169.79 crores in terms of the provisions of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 read with the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002.
- The Board of Directors have approved a Composite Scheme of Arrangement between Kesoram Industries Limited, the Company and their respective shareholders and creditors, in compliance with sections 230 to 232 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Scheme"). The Scheme, inter alia, provides for (a) merger of the Cement Business of Kesoram into the Company, and (b) reduction and cancellation of the preference share capital of Kesoram. The Cement Business of Kesoram consists of 2 integrated cement units at Sedam (Karnataka) and Basantnagar (Telangana) with a total installed capacity of 10.75 mtpa and 0.66 mtpa packing plant at Solapur, Maharashtra. The Company will issue 1 (one) equity share of the Company of face value ₹ 10/- each for every 52 (fifty-two) equity shares of Kesoram of face value ₹ 10/- each to the shareholders of Kesoram as on the record date defined in the Scheme. The Scheme is, inter alia, subject to receipt of requisite approvals from statutory and regulatory authorities, including from the stock exchanges, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), the National Company Law Tribunals, the Competition Commission of India and the shareholders and creditors of the Company.
- The Company incorporated a Wholly-owned Subsidiary viz. "Letein Valley Cement Limited" in Shillong, Meghalaya on 16/01/2024 to carry on the business of mining of limestone and other raw materials, manufacture and sale of cement.
- During the nine months ended 31/12/2023, provision for current and deferred tax expenses has been recognized as per the new tax regime adopted by the Company from the financial year 2023-24 in terms of provision of Section 115BAA of Income Tax Act, 1961.
- In terms of a Scheme of Arrangement between Jaiprakash Associates Limited (JAL), Jaypee Cement Corporation Limited (JCCL), the Company ("The Parties") and their respective shareholders and creditors, sanctioned by the National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai and Allahabad bench, together with necessary approvals from the stock exchanges, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), and the Competition Commission of India, the Company had on 27/06/2017, issued Series A Redeemable Preference Shares of ₹ 1,000 crores to JAL (Series A RPS) for a period of 5 years or such longer period as may be agreed by the Parties ("The Terms"). The Series A RPS were held in escrow until satisfaction of certain conditions precedent in relation to the Dalla Super Plant and mines situated in the state of Uttar Pradesh (Earlier known as JP Super), to be redeemed post the expiry of the Term as per the agreement between the Parties. Upon expiry of the Term, the Company offered redemption of the Series A RPS within the stipulated number of days, post adjustment of certain costs pertaining to the conditions precedent, as per the terms of the agreement entered into between the Parties. Redemption of the Series A RPS was subject to issuance of a joint notice to the escrow agent. The Series A RPS could not be redeemed due to inaction on the part of JAL in signing the joint instruction notice. This matter has since been referred to arbitration and the proceedings are pending.
- The Company had filed appeals against the orders of the Competition Commission of India (CCI) dated 31/08/2016 (Penalty of ₹ 1,449.51 Crores) and 19/01/2017 (Penalty of ₹ 68.30 Crores). Upon the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal ("NCLAT") disallowing its appeal against the CCI order dated 31/08/2016, the Company filed an appeal before Hon'ble Supreme Court which has, by its order dated 05/10/2018, granted a stay against the NCLAT order. Consequently, the Company has deposited an amount of ₹ 144.95 Crores equivalent to 10% of the penalty of ₹ 1,449.51 Crores. The Company, backed by legal opinions, believes that it has a good case in both the matters and accordingly no provision has been recognised in the results. UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Ltd (UNCL) has also filed an appeal before Hon'ble Supreme Court against a similar CCI order dated 31/08/2016 and has deposited an amount of ₹ 16.73 Crores equivalent to 10% of the penalty amount of ₹ 167.32 Crores. The Company, backed by legal opinion believes that it has a good case in the said matter and accordingly no provision has been recognised in the results.
