REPORT OF THE SCRUTINIZER ON THE MEETING OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF ULTRATECH CEMENT LIMITED (CONVENED PURSUANT TO ORDER DATED 4TH JULY, 2023 OF THE HON'BLE NATIONAL COMPANY LAW TRIBUNAL, (NCLT) MUMBAI BENCH)

Dear Sir,

- I, B. Narasimhan, a Practicing Company Secretary was appointed as Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting and e-voting held at the meeting of the unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) of UltraTech Cement Limited ("the Company"), held on Monday the 4th September 2023 at 11:30 a.m., on the resolution seeking approval of the unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) to the Scheme of Amalgamation of UltraTech Nathdwara Cement Limited, Swiss Merchandise Infrastructure Limited and Merit Plaza Limited (collectively referred to as "Transferor Companies") with UltraTech Cement Limited ("Transferee Company") (hereinafter referred to as "Scheme"), and submit our report as under:
- Pursuant to the said order dated 4th July, 2023 of the Hon'ble National 1. Company Law Tribunal ("NCLT"), Mumbai Bench, the aforesaid Meeting of unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) of the Transferee Company was held through video conferencing / other audio visual means ("VC / OAVM"), without the physical presence of the unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) at a common venue and in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act") and framework for holding meetings through VC / OAVM, as prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs General Circular No.14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, as clarified / extended from time to time, including by General Circulars bearing No.17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, No.22/2020 dated 15th June, 2020, No.33/2020 dated 28th September, 2020, No.39/2020 dated 31st December, 2020, No.10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, No.20/2021 dated 8th December. 2021, No. 3/2022 dated 5th May, 2022 and No.11/2022 dated 28th December, 2022 ("Virtual Meeting Circulars").

- 2. As per the direction of the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai by its Order dated 4th July, 2023:
 - the Transferee Company had sent the Notice dated 31st July, 2023 convening the meeting to its unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) numbering to 15,145, by email and in respect of the balance 1,072 unsecured creditors whose email id were not registered with the Transferee Company, the individual notices were sent by speed post.
 - the Notice convening the meeting contained the detailed procedures for attending the meeting through VC / OAVM.
 - the Notice also contained the detailed procedures for remote e-voting and also for e-voting at the meeting.
 - Notice of the meeting of the unsecured creditors was duly published in the newspapers on 3rd August, 2023 both in English Language in 'Business Standard', having nationwide circulation and in Marathi Language in "Navshakti', Mumbai edition.
 - Notice of the meeting of the unsecured creditors have also been uploaded on the website of the Transferee Company at https://www.ultratechcement.com/investors/corporategovernance#scheme of arrangement, as well as on the website of KFin Technologies Limited ('KFIN') as the Service provider at https://evoting.kfintech.com and also on the websites of the Stock Exchanges viz, BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com and National Stock Exchange of India Limited, at www.nseindia.com
- 3. In terms of the NCLT Order, quorum for the meeting was fixed as 30 unsecured creditors. The meeting was attended by 78 unsecured creditors.
- 4. The remote e-voting was kept open for the period from Friday, 1st September, 2023, 9.00 a.m. IST till Sunday 3rd September, 2023, 5.00 p.m. IST.
- 5. The Company had appointed KFin as the Service provider, for the purpose of extending the facility of remote e-voting to the unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders) of the Transferee Company and for voting electronically at the meeting. KFIN is also the Registrar and Transfer Agents ('RTA') of the Transferee Company. The Service Provider had provided a system for recording the votes of the unsecured creditors electronically through remote e-voting as well as at the meeting on the item of business sought to be transacted in the meeting.
- 6. The meeting convened on Monday, 4th September, 2023 at 11:30 a.m. IST.
- 7. After the meeting concluded, the Chairman of the meeting asked those unsecured creditors (including debenture holders and bond holders), who had secret

- not voted through remote e-voting, to cast their votes within a period of 15 minutes and thereafter declared the meeting as closed and asked the Scrutinizer to submit a combined Report of both the remote e-voting and the e-voting at the meeting.
- 8. After the 15 minutes period allotted for e-voting was over, I unblocked the votes cast through e-voting at the meeting and the remote e-voting, in the presence of Ms. Kashish Tekchandani and Ms. Tejaswini Bhandarkar Witnesses to the unblocking of the voting.
- 9. The results of the Remote E-voting together with the e-voting conducted during the meeting convened by the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai Bench are as under:
